NOTE: Dogs and Bitches competing in the veteran may be neutered or spayed.

### NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

**Stud Dog Class** – For dogs that have sired two to four dogs or bitches entered in this Show. The award will be based on the merits of the two to four get, get only to be judged. The Stud Dog must appear in the ring with his two to four get and be entered in the Stud Dog Class.

**Brood Bitch Class** – For Bitches that have whelped two to four dogs or bitches entered in this Show. The award will be based on the merits of the two to four produce, produce only to be judged. The Brood Bitch must appear in the ring with her two to four produce and be entered in the Brood Bitch Class.

As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch classes will be based on the merits of more than one dog or bitch, no one of the dogs or bitches making up the entry judged first in the class will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class.

**Brace Class** – For two dogs and/or bitches of the same breed with at least one owner in common.

## **BEST OF BREED COMPETITION**

### **JUDGE'S AWARD OF MERIT**

The judge may at his/her discretion award a maximum of 4 Awards of Merit. The Borzoi who have already been declared BOB, BOS, SD, SB, BOW, WD, and WB will not be eligible for Award of Merit.

### **SPECIALTY TROPHIES**

Trophies for Best of Breed, Best Opposite Sex to Best of Breed, Select Dog, Select Bitch, Best of Winners, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Reserve Winners Dog, Reserve Winners Bitch, Best Puppy, and Best Veteran, are graciously donated from the Estate of Pat Ellis-Ulloa by her husband Dr. Joseph Ulloa.

### **All class placements will receive Spray Bottles**

Ribbons and Rosettes – Ribbon colors are noted in breed portion of this premium list. The Borzoi Club of California will offer Rosettes for Best of Breed, Best Opposite Sex, Best of Winners, Winners, Reserves, and Selects.

Award of Merit, Best Puppy in Specialty and Best Veteran in Specialty – Green and White Rosette

Best Puppy Classification – Best Puppy competition will be for winners of the puppy dog and puppy bitch 6-9 and 9-12 regular classes **and** bred by exhibitor dogs and bitches 6 months & under 12 months only. Dogs over 12 months of age are not considered puppies.

Best Veteran Classification – Best Veteran competition will be for the winners of the Veteran dog and bitch 7 yrs. & under 9 yrs. and 9 yrs. & older classes only.

Judging will take place after Best of Breed Competition and after the Stud Dog and Brood Bitch classes.

### **BEST OF BREED ULLOA MEMORIAL TROPHY**

In memory of Mrs. Patricia Ulloa. Pat was a long-time member of BCOC. The perpetual trophy is a Borzoi head piece mounted on a hardwood base and donated to the club by the Dr. Joseph Ulloa to be offered at the Borzoi Club of California Specialty. For permanent possession, the trophy must be won three times by the identical owner(s) and co-owners, not necessarily with the same dog. The trophy will remain in possession of the Borzoi Club of California and displayed at the Specialty until retired.

Puppy Sweepstakes is held to encourage the showing of promising Borzoi puppies. Sweepstakes is held prior to the Regular Breed Classes. **All entries in Puppy Sweepstakes must be entered in a Regular Class at this show. HANDLERS: No dog may be handled by a professional handler or his/her paid assistant unless the handler is a registered owner of the dog.** The specific Sweepstakes class must be given on the entry blank in the place for additional classes. State class as "Sweepstakes 6-9 mos. Dog" or whatever class is appropriate. FEE: \$20.00 in addition to the regular class fee.

Veteran Sweepstakes is held to celebrate our older dogs that still grace us with their presence. Veteran Sweepstakes will be held prior to the Regular Breed Classes and prior to Puppy Sweepstakes. Entries in Veteran Sweepstakes need not be entered in any other class at this show. State class as "Veterans Sweepstakes 7 years & under 9, or 9 years & older." FEE: \$20.00 in addition to the regular class fee if applicable

Ribbons and Rosettes (Sweepstakes) - The Borzoi Club of California will offer a Green and Pink Rosette for Best Puppy Dog in Sweepstakes and Best Puppy Bitch in Sweepstakes. The Borzoi Club of California will offer a Green and Pink Rosette to Best Veteran Dog in Sweepstakes and Best Veteran Bitch in Sweepstakes.

Classes Puppies: (Divided by sex) 6 mos. & under 9 mos., 9 mos. & under 12 mos., 12 mos. & under 15 mos., 15 mos. & under 18 mos.

Classes Veterans: (Divided by sex) 7 years & under 9 years of age, and 9 years & over.

PRIZE MONEY: Funds collected for Sweepstakes will be distributed as follows: FIRST PLACE 30%, SECOND PLACE 25%, THIRD PLACE 15% and FOURTH PLACE 10%. The Borzoi Club of California will retain 20% to cover expenses.

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. #### INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.

3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. age division, color division, weight division.

4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

5. Mixed Breed dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
